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Consignment Agreement

Thank you for your interest in becoming a consignor with Ozark Folkways!
As a 501(c)(3) organization, we celebrate the preservation, instruction, and development of Ozark arts, crafts, and music. We seek to promote individuals whose work fits that mission.

SELECTION OF WORK

The selection of work for sale and/or display at Ozark Folkways is at the sole discretion of the committee put in place by the Ozark Folkways board of directors. This committee seeks to provide balance and diversity in types, skill levels, and artists and craftspeople represented, as guided by the mission of Ozark Folkways.

Ozark Folkways seeks Ozark artists and craftspeople. Strong preference is given to those who reside within 100 miles of Winslow, Arkansas.

I have read the art selection policy.

COMMISSION

A 30% sales commission will be deducted from the price of every item sold and will be retained in the general fund of Ozark Folkways. Thus, 70% of the final sales price, before tax, will be paid to the consignor.

We are more than happy to work with you to set pricing that is reflective of similar work we have recently inventoried or sold.

I have read, understand, and agree to the commission policy.

ONE-TIME STOCKING FEE

Separate from the sales commission, each consignor is required to pay a \$40.00 general stocking fee.

This fee must be paid before work is exhibited.

DELIVERY OF WORK

Without prior arrangements, consignors shall not mail to or drop off items at Ozark Folkways.

I have read, understand, and agree to the distribution policy.

BARCODES

Ozark Folkways will barcode each item received and each item shall be inventoried into the Square system upon delivery by the consignor. If items are to be removed from Folkways, they shall be properly "checked out" with shop keeper to be removed from the Square inventory.

I have read, understand, and agree to the barcode policy.

CONTACT INFORMATION

It is the responsibility of you, the consignor, to ensure accurate contact information is provided and remains on file. Repeated attempts to contact an individual without success may result in reduced sale price or disposal of merchandise at the discretion of Ozark Folkways.

PAYMENT SCHEDULE

Commission from sales will be paid electronically on or about the tenth of each month. Commissions are paid in the month immediately following the month in which the sales were made. Ozark Folkways will send an emailed monthly recap of sales to each consignor at the email address on file. Consignors shall agree to supply appropriate account information to receive electronic distributions.

DISPLAYED MERCHANDISE

Display, placement, and seasonal arrangement of items are the sole and final discretion of the Ozark Folkways sales staff. All items which are easily soiled and/or damaged should be packaged in a protective, attractive manner. If an item has not sold in one year, the consignor shall agree to change out said item for another item.

PROMOTIONAL MATERIAL

Each consignor shall provide a brief bio, artist’s statement, and a high-resolution photo of themselves for promotional use, as well as high-resolution imagery of at least three (3) items that are for sale.
